

## LTAT Launches "Bersama Wira" Campaign

Honouring the Sacrifice of Malaysia's Heroes

**KUALA LUMPUR**, **22 September 2025** – Lembaga Tabung Angkatan Tentera ("LTAT") today launched the BERSAMA WIRA campaign, further strengthening its commitment to its mission of Advancing the Socio-economic Well-being of Our Members.

The campaign enables the public to give back to our national heroes in line with the whole-ofnation approach. Beneficiaries include Malaysian Armed Forces ("MAF") families facing critical illnesses or enduring financial hardships across MAF camps nationwide.

Funds raised will be channelled into providing care packages containing daily essentials and basic needs, sourced from Perbadanan Perwira Niaga Malaysia ("PERNAMA"), LTAT's wholly-owned corporation that operates a network of retail outlets and distribution services for members of the MAF and their families.
